Second, we cut out the person.



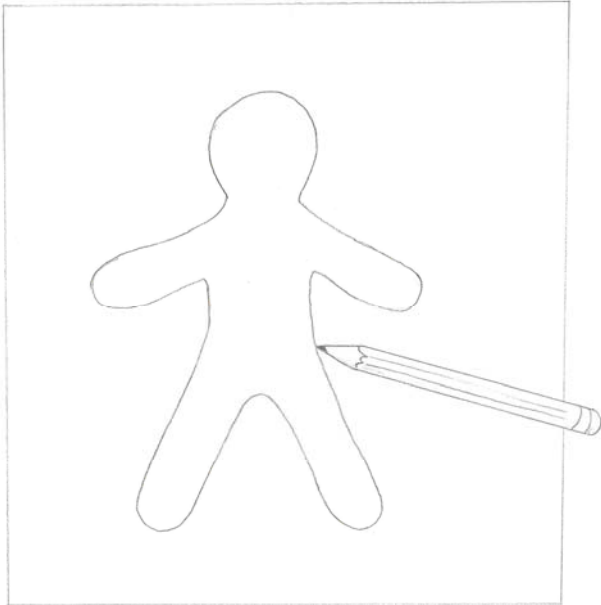
^{3rd}

Fourth, we decorated the person.

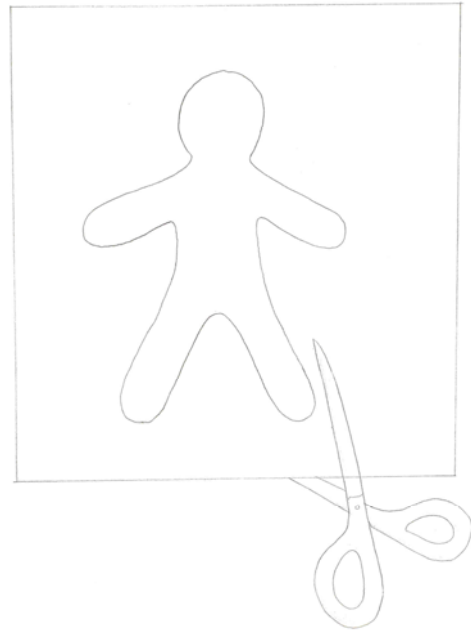



Finally, we glued the person to a

popsicle stick.
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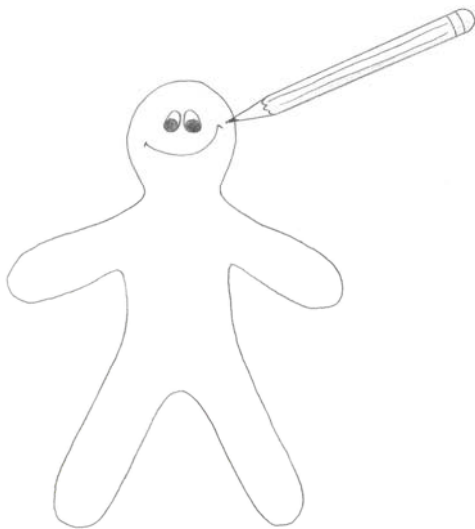
Trace a person on a piece of construction paper.

Draw a face or glue on a picture of your face.



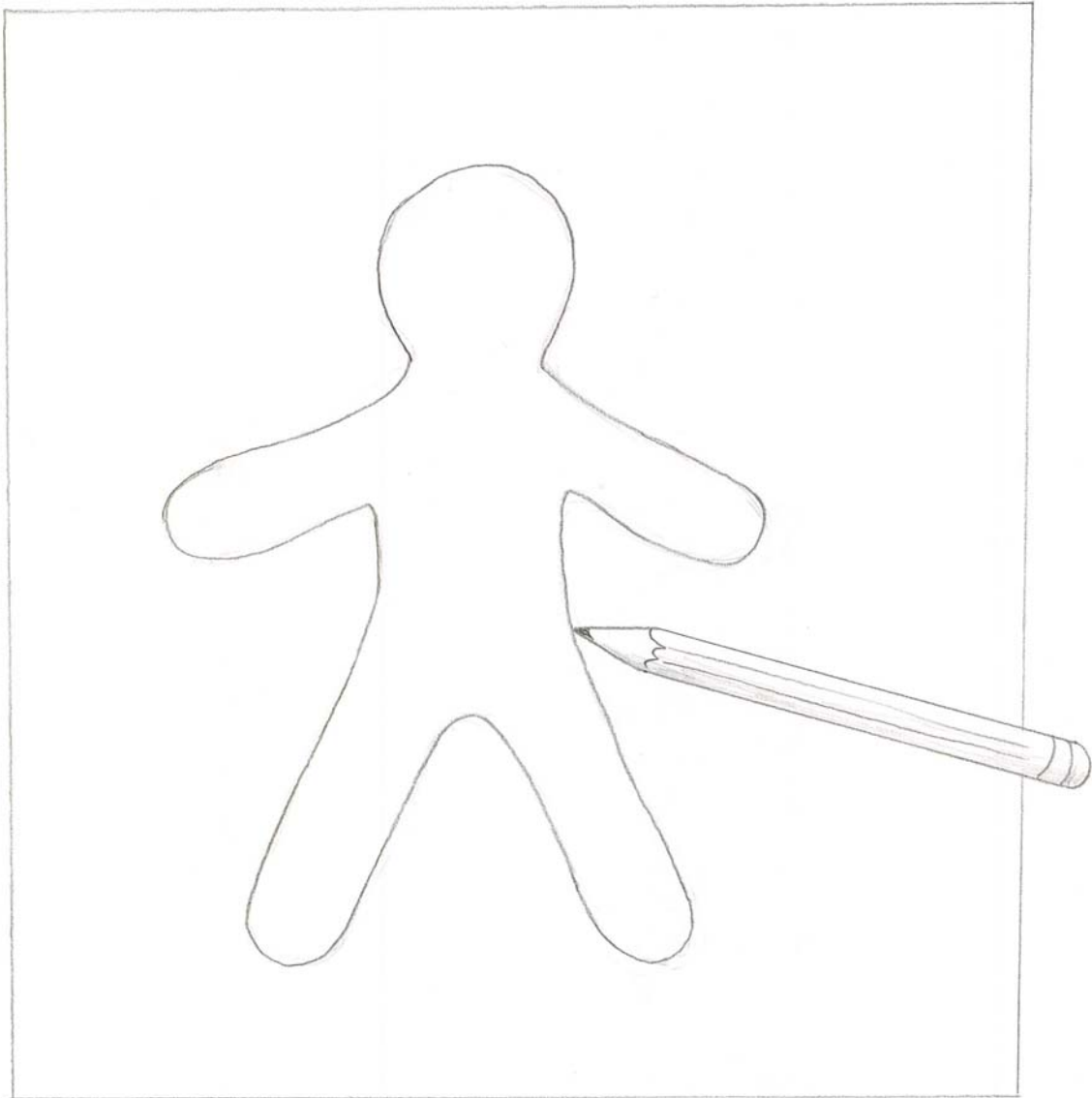
Decorate the person using craft items.



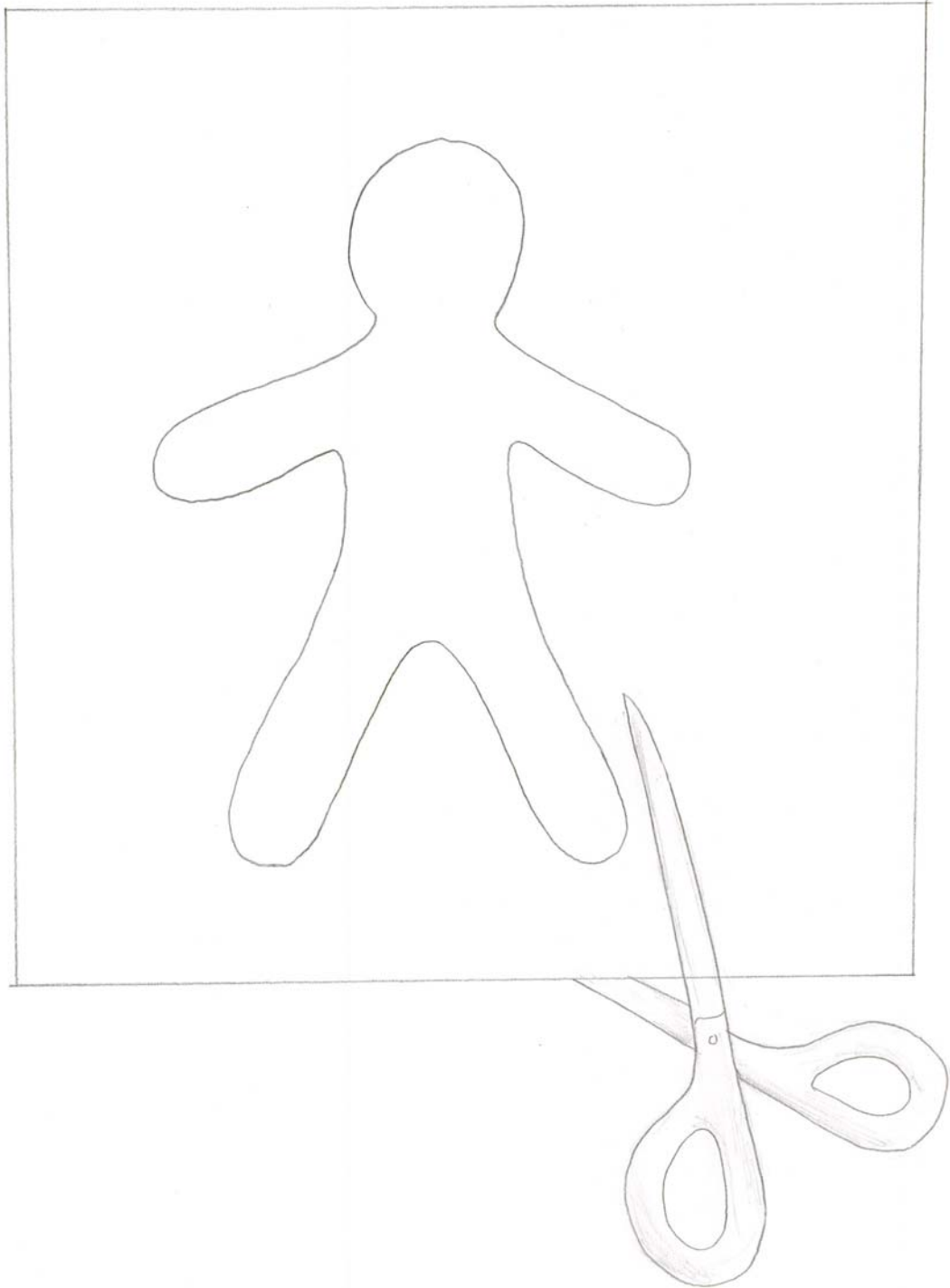
Glue the person to a popsicle stick.



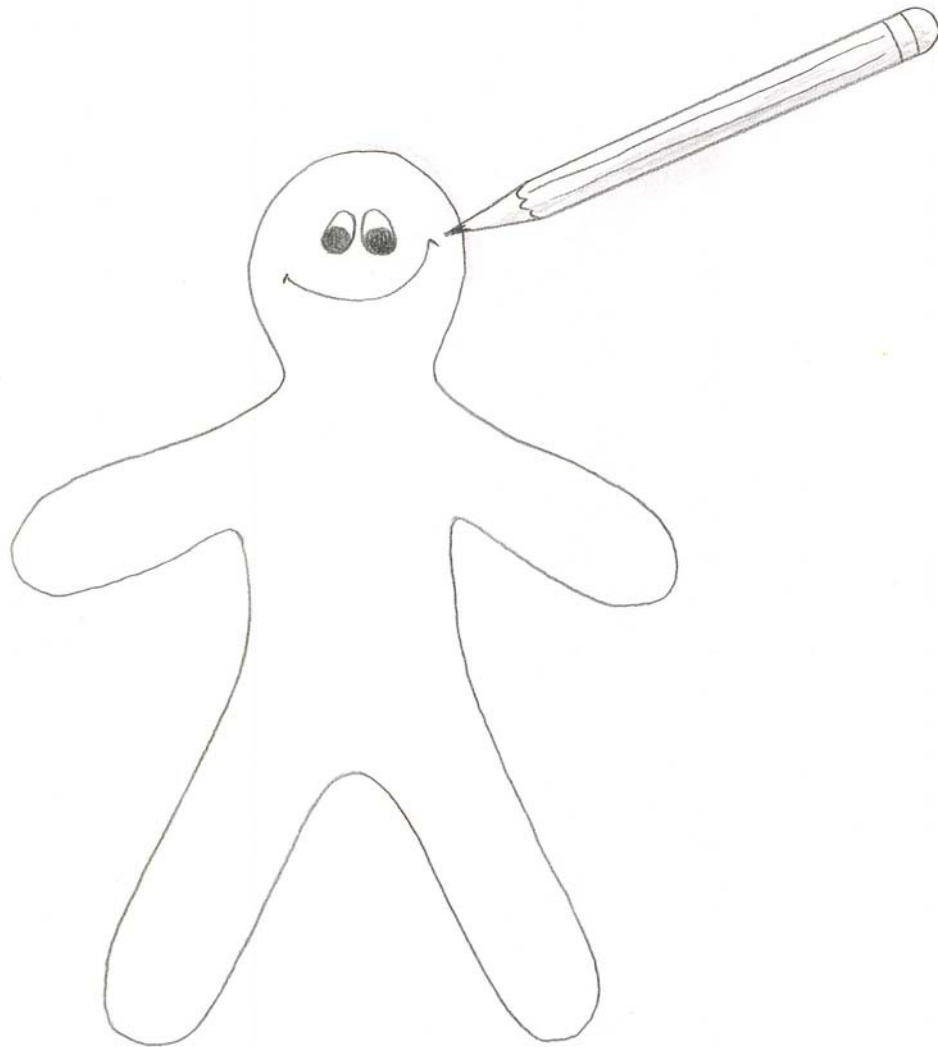
Trace a person on a piece of construction paper.



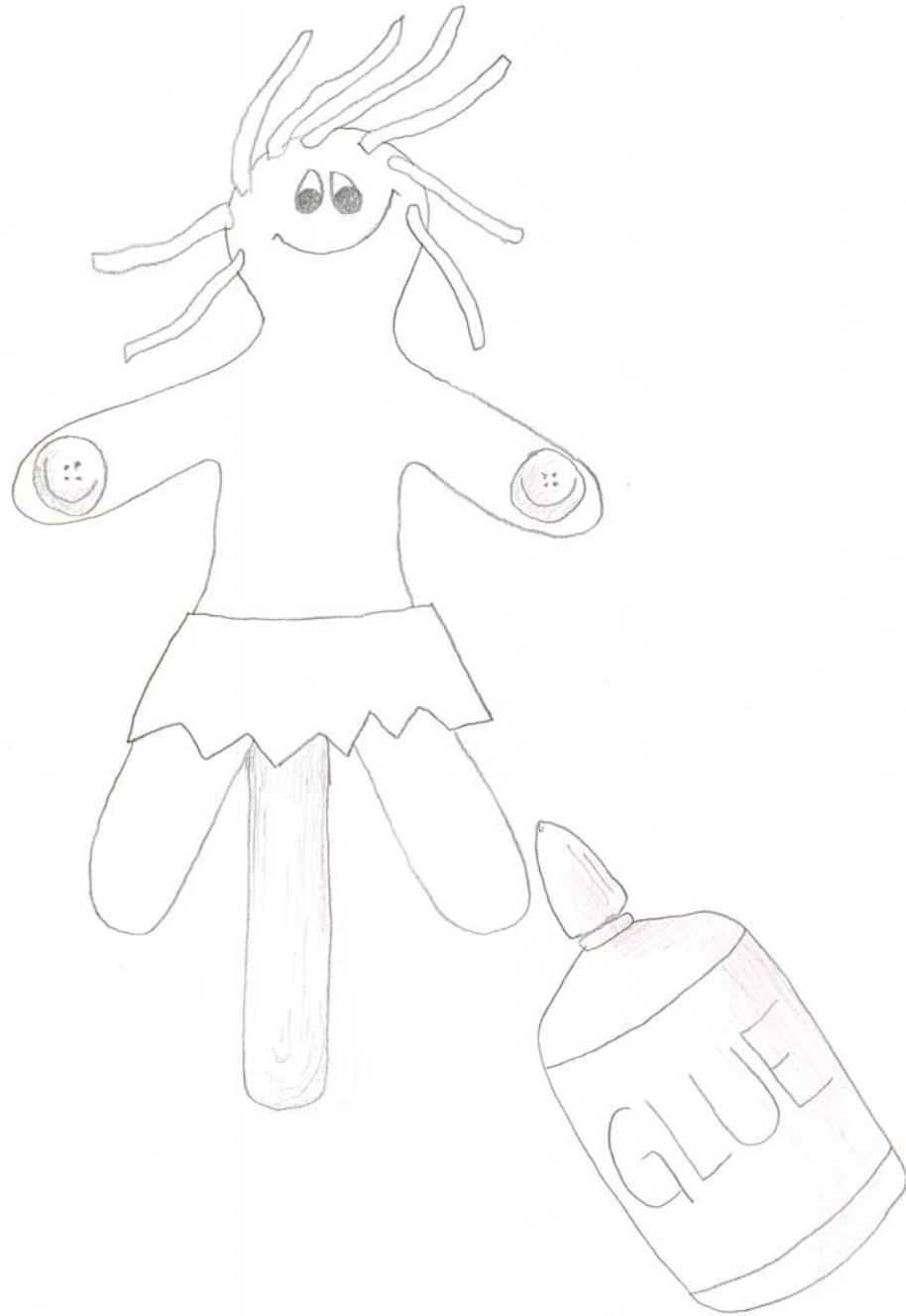
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
